Process of Initiation for non-baptized individuals, Christians of the other faiths who wish to become Catholic, Catholics who have not received Holy Communion, or Confirmation and for Catholics who are interested in deepening their faith.

SPECIAL SACRAMENTS (RCIC)

Process of initiation into the Catholic Church for baptized children under the age of 15 and children over the age of 8 who have not yet received their first Holy Communion.

CONFIRMATION

Contact the CCD office for dates Confirmation will be made available.

HOLY COMMUNION

Children must have completed the two year preparation process to enter the Sacramental class in the third grade.

MARRIAGE

For registered parishioners 1) Interview with parish priest six months before the wedding. 2) Diocesan marriage preparation program.

BAPTISM

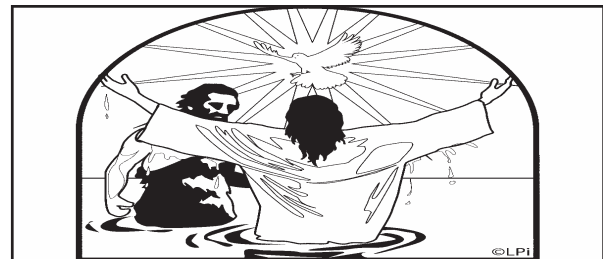

MISSION STATEMENT

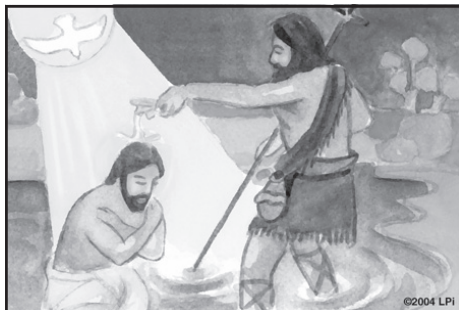
Our faith-family of Immaculate Conception and its rich history and traditions, invite all Catholics to help them grow and mature as faithful followers of Jesus Christ.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Many Christian communities regard the Baptism of the Lord as the completion of the Christmas cycle. It is the last recorded epiphanic event of which Jesus is publicly acclaimed as the one who is to come — “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.” With this divine endorsement Jesus now moves on to his work of proclaiming the good news and the promises of the new kingdom. He moves not as a spirited prophet, but more like a servant, similar to what Isaiah describes in the first reading. The first sentence: “Here is my servant whom I uphold, my chosen one, with whom I am pleased; upon whom I put my spirit; he shall bring forth justice to the nations.” Jesus fits the “job description.”

From this public revelation of Jesus as commissioned by God, he moves as healer, teacher, friend, counselor, and herald of a new kingdom that is not like any other kingdom. It is not of this world. It is this last element that will cause great consternation among his disciples who maintained that he would be the general to lead them into overthrowing Rome. Jesus was expected to set up a new cadre of leaders and/or tyrants to expel the invaders.

They were wrong. They were obstinate in not believing that Jesus’ reign was not what they expected. As we continue in the subsequent Sundays it is important to note the reactions of the followers of Jesus when he works a miracle, when he espouses an outcast, when he does all the works of mercy unheard of in his society. Just what one would expect of a Son of God in whom God “is well pleased,” much to the confusion and disappointment of those who were closed to him.
