CONFIRMATION

HOLY COMMUNION

Children must have completed the two year preparation process to enter the Sacramental class in the third grade.

For registered parishioners 1) Interview with parish priest six months before the wedding. 2) Diocesan marriage preparation program.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The translation in the lectionary of the Lord's Prayer might seem a little abrupt in the verse "And do not subject us to the final test." Most of us have been reared with "lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil." So far, there has not been much commentary on how final *final* is and what constitutes the final test.

What might be closer to the message of Jesus is not what we pray about but more about being open to God's response to what we are praying for. After all, it was his Son who taught us how to pray. Of course, by the time we have it after who-knows-how-many emendations and embolismic attachments (e.g., "for thine is the kingdom . . ."), we pray that which we know and claim as our own.

Jesus covers all prayer requests as he addresses God as Father, as he asks for "daily nourishment (physical and spiritual bread), release from guilt and hopelessness in forgiveness, and the power to resist evil . . . It is for this fullness of the kingdom that Jesus bids his disciples pray. A bold prayer indeed"

With that kind of authentic prayer, we just might get the loaves that the man in the gospel begged from his friends. What we also might get is a surprise, in the sense of something more than we counted on—a renewal of our relationship to God, father and protector, creator and source of what we pray for. Who never sleeps

The balance of hours—light and dark—comes twice a year. At that moment the sun is directly over the equator and day and night are equal. In spring and in autumn the equinox takes hold and the seasons change. With central heating and electric lights we are less attuned to the natural world, the change of seasons, and the rhythm of the day. But we cannot erase the tug of the seasons even if we leave the lights on all night or heat our home as warm as a desert landscape. Spring breaks upon us as vibrantly as the crack of ice in the melting sun. And the promise of more light brightens our mood as well as our day. While the moment of the equinox itself may pass us by, it is not difficult to take a bit of time and find a hint of spring to cheer our heart—a budding leaf, a ray of sun, a blossom.

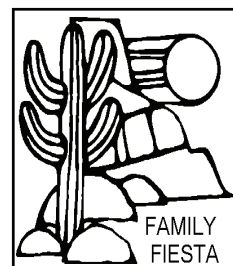
