Minutes for October 20, 2010 Meeting

The meeting was called to order and the minutes for the meeting of October 6th, 2010 were discussed and accepted. Chairman Torres welcomed our visitor.

The meeting commenced with Chairman Torres informing the Tome Church Restoration Committee that the Archdioceses has placed a moratorium on all preservation work until a "work-plan" is developed, presented and approved by the Archbishop's Commission for the Preservation of Historic New Mexico Churches. The Tome Church Restoration Committee was given a week to put together a written plan and have it presented to the Archbishop's commission. The plan was to include what has been done (completed), what needs to be done and what are the steps necessary to complete the restoration process. The presentation is to be given on Wednesday, October 27, 2010 at 1:30 pm at the Chancellery in Albuquerque.

Carlos Sanchez came prepared to the meeting with an outline of a power point presentation which was edited for use in the development of a "working plan." The same data would be used in developing collateral materials to be given to committee members of the Archbishop's Commission for the Preservation of Historic New Mexico Churches. The committee went through Carlo's extensive work and began the arduous editing process. Carlos took suggestions from committee members and committed to overseeing the development of the plan document and place it on a Power Point Presentation. In the interim, Committee members are to provide Carlos with additional information to be added to the presentation and collateral materials. Committee members, in the coming days are asked to help in the "flow" and editing of the document. All members believed that the committee was heading in the right direction.

All committee members agreed that the presentation should be clear, concise and simple to understand. It was advised that voting members of the Tome Church Restoration Committee make the presentation. Members making the presentation are as follows; Ramon Torres, Martin Romero, Brandon Jaramillo, Carlos Sanchez, and Rick Trujillo.

Another topic of conversation during this meeting was the status/warranty of the existing non-working—leaking- gutters on the north wall. Angelo spoke with Randy Silva about the issue and was not given a straight answer. Jerry offered to talk to John Kirkpatrick and Dora Gomez to determine if a warranty exists for the work when it was contracted. Jerry will report at the next meeting.

Next Building Restoration Committee meeting will be scheduled once we are given the OK to continue restoration work from the Archbishop's Commission for the Preservation of Historic New Mexico Churches.
